

Yes, they **do**. / No, they **don't**.

**Does** Chris **live** in a house?

Yes, he **does**. / No, he **doesn't**.

**Does** the house **have** a yard?

Yes, it **does**. / No, it **doesn't**.


A: Yes, I **do** / **does**. But my wife **don't** / **doesn't**.

Usamos **Do** con los pronombres *I, you, we* y *they*, y **Does** con los pronombres *he, she* e *it*.

Pronoun	Conjugation
I	Do
He She It	Does
You We They	Do
