Tapachula is a Mexican city located in the Soconusco Region, on the South Coast of the state of Chiapas and on the border with Guatemala. It is the second most populated and important city in Chiapas.

The Miguel Hidalgo Central Park or Plaza de Armas, you can see a roofed forum where cultural events are scheduled such as; dancing, photographic exhibitions, musical events where passersby sit and watch on the benches that surround the forum. On one side of this there is a kiosk where the local marimba delights its visitors. From the central park you can see the new government palace, the Church of San Agustín, the House of Culture (Old government palace) and the Archaeological Museum of Soconusco.

Also in front of the government palace there are two sculptures of the forgers of independence, where these full-lengths commemorate the two characters who gave independence to Chiapas.

You can find in the surroundings different commercial businesses, open to the public, clothing stores, technology etc.




