The center of Tapachula Chiapas is surrounded by the streets 9th North Avenue, Eighth West Street, West 11th Street, North Central. There is the Miguel Hidalgo central park, the Tapachula municipal palace, the archaeological museum of the soconusco, the Sebastián Market, the jarrones restaurant, the Tapachula hotel, madrigal tacos, pizza dominos and church.

Tapachula is a Mexican city located in the Soconusco Region, on the South Coast of the state of Chiapas and on the border with Guatemala. It is the second most populated and important city in Chiapas.

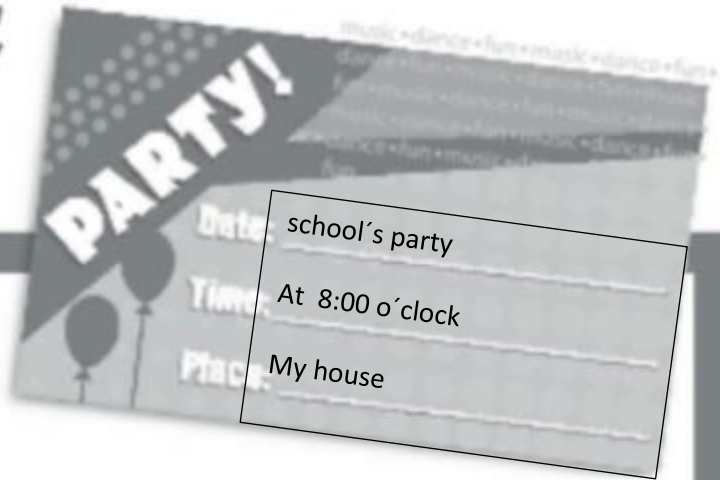
