

TAPACHULA

It is a Mexican city located in the Soconusco Region, on the South Coast of the state of Chiapas and on the border with Guatemala.

MIGUEL HIDALGO CENTRAL PARK

It is located in the center of the city of Tapachula. There is a covered forum where musical events, dances, exhibitions and other types of cultural events are held. There is also a kiosk where the local marimba delights visitors. The park is located near the Municipal Palace, the House of Culture and the Museum of Soconusco.



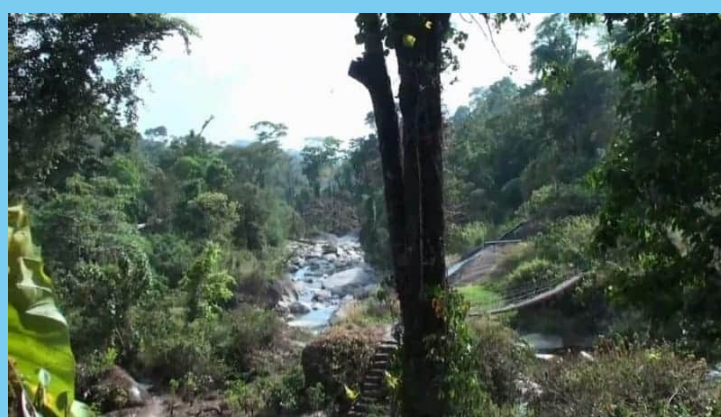
MUSEUM OF TAPACHULA



The old Municipal Palace was restored and converted into the current Tapachula Museum. On the façade there is a huge clock, brought by Porfirio Díaz from France in the 19th century and which maintains its original pieces. The main objective of the museum is to recognize the trajectory and significance of this Mexican city, located where the nation begins. In this place you can learn about the history of the Sonocusco region.

ROUTE OF COFFEE

It is one of the main tourist attractions in Tapachula. You have to go through a stretch of jungle vegetation to find the coffee farms, approximately 20 minutes on foot. At the beginning there were 15 farms, although today 4 are maintained and in each of them you can enjoy different types of coffee, as well as different production processes.



TACANA VOLCANO



It is located in Tapachula and its altitude is 4100 meters. There are different types of ecosystems, from high jungle, pine forests, cloud forest and grasslands. It is the hiking route preferred by tourists, since from above there are spectacular views of the city, rivers, the sea and beautiful dreamlike landscapes.
