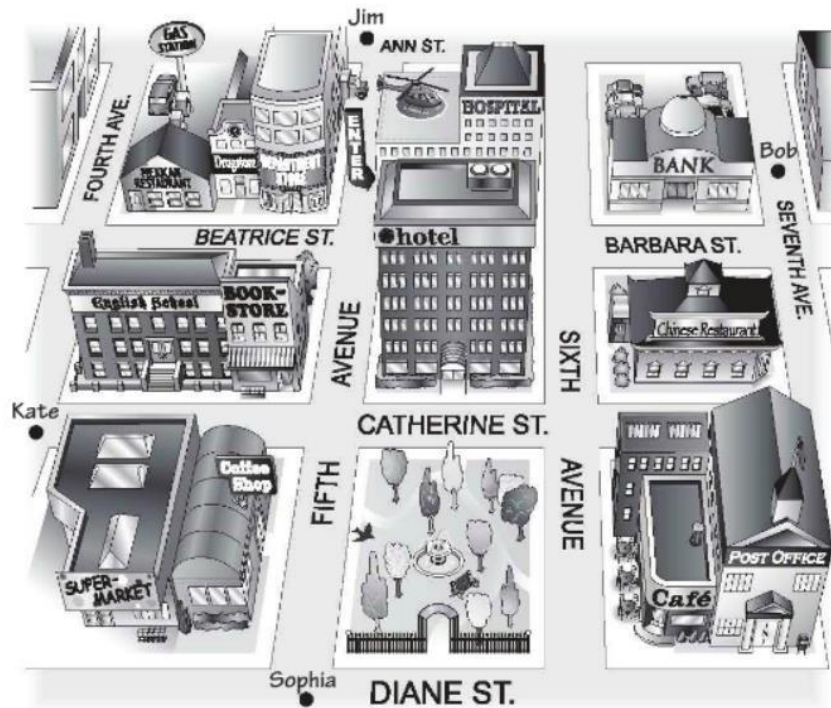

SKETCH OF THE CENTER OF TAPACHULA



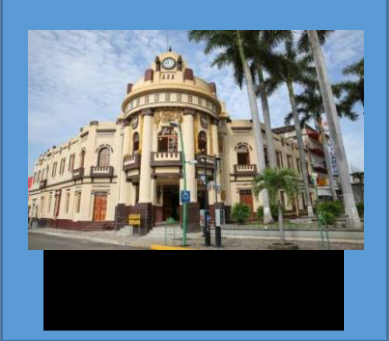
