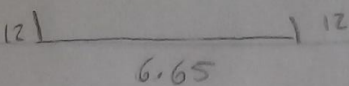

VOLUMEN DE OBRA

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**Varilla no. 3** 

► longitudinal

$$\text{Largo} = 6.65 + 0.24 = 6.89 \text{ m (9 piezas)} = 27.56 \text{ m}$$

► transversal

$$\text{Largo} = 80 + 24 = 1.04 \text{ m} \quad \text{12} \quad \text{80} \quad \text{12}$$

$$\text{Piezas} = 6.65 / 0.15 + 1 = 45.3 \rightarrow 46$$

$$1.04 \text{ m (46 piezas)} = 47.84 \text{ m}$$

► Contrate

$$\text{Largo} = 6 + 0.24 = 6.24 \text{ m (2 piezas)} = 12.48 \text{ m} \quad \text{12} \quad \text{6.00} \quad \text{12}$$

► Total de varilla no. 3

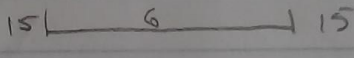
$$27.56 \text{ m} + 47.84 \text{ m} + 12.48 \text{ m} = 87.88 \text{ (1.03)} = 90.5164$$

► Total de kg

$$90.5164 (0.566) = 51.23 \text{ kg}$$

► Total de piezas

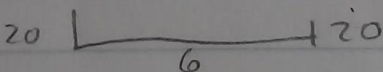
$$90.5164 / 12 = 7.54 \rightarrow 8 \text{ piezas}$$

**Varilla no. 4** 

$$\text{Largo} = 6 + 0.30 = 6.30 \text{ m (2 piezas)} = 12.6 (1.05) = 13.23$$

$$\text{kg} = 13.23 (0.997) = 13.14 \text{ kg}$$

$$\text{Piezas} = 13.23 / 12 = 1.1025 \rightarrow 1 \text{ pieza}$$

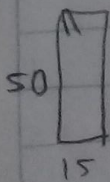
**Varilla no. 5** 

$$\text{Largo} = 6 + 0.40 = 6.40 \text{ m (2 piezas)} = 12.8 \text{ m (1.07)} = 13.696$$

$$\text{kg} = 13.696 (1.566) = 21.44$$

$$\text{Pieza} = 13.696 / 12 = 1.14 \rightarrow 1 \text{ pieza}$$

**Varilla no. 2 (estribo)**



$$\text{Largo} = 1.30 + 0.14 = 1.44 \text{ m}$$

$$\text{Pieza} = 6 / 0.15 + 1 = 41 \text{ piezas}$$

$$\text{Largo total} = 1.44 \text{ m (41 piezas)} = 59.04 (1.03) = 60.81 \text{ m}$$

$$\text{kg} = 60.81 (0.250) = 15.2025 \text{ kg}$$

### Excavación

$$\text{Base} = 0.80 + 0.20 = 1.00 \text{ m}$$

$$\text{Largo} = 6.65 + 0.20 = 6.85 \text{ m}$$

$$\text{altura} = 1.15 \text{ m}$$

$$7.8775 (1.30) = 10.24 \text{ m}^3$$

### concreto $f'c = 100 \text{ kg/m}^2$

$$1 \text{ m} \times 6.85 \text{ m} \times 0.05 \text{ m} = 0.3425 (1.1) = 0.376 \text{ m}^3$$

### concreto $f'c = 200 \text{ kg/m}^2$

$$\text{Sección 1} = 0.8 \text{ m} \times 0.15 \text{ m} \times 6.65 \text{ m} = 0.798 \text{ m}^3$$

$$\text{Sección 2} = 0.15 \text{ m} \times 0.35 \text{ m} \times 6.00 \text{ m} = 0.315 \text{ m}^3$$

$$1.113 \text{ m}^3 (1.05) = 1.168 \text{ m}^3$$
