It is formed with the auxiliary verb "TO BE" conjugating (am, is, are) plus the form "going to" which in Spanish corresponds to "I'm going to" plus a verb in simple form, plus the possible complement of the sentence. The form "GOING TO" expresses the intention of the subject to execute a certain future action.
