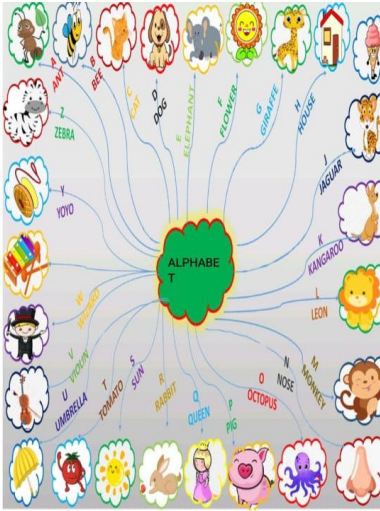


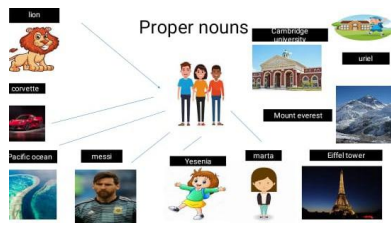


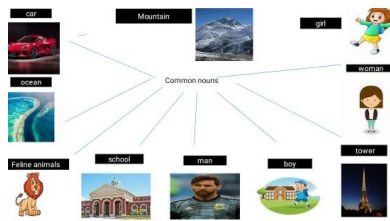
Theme: nouns
