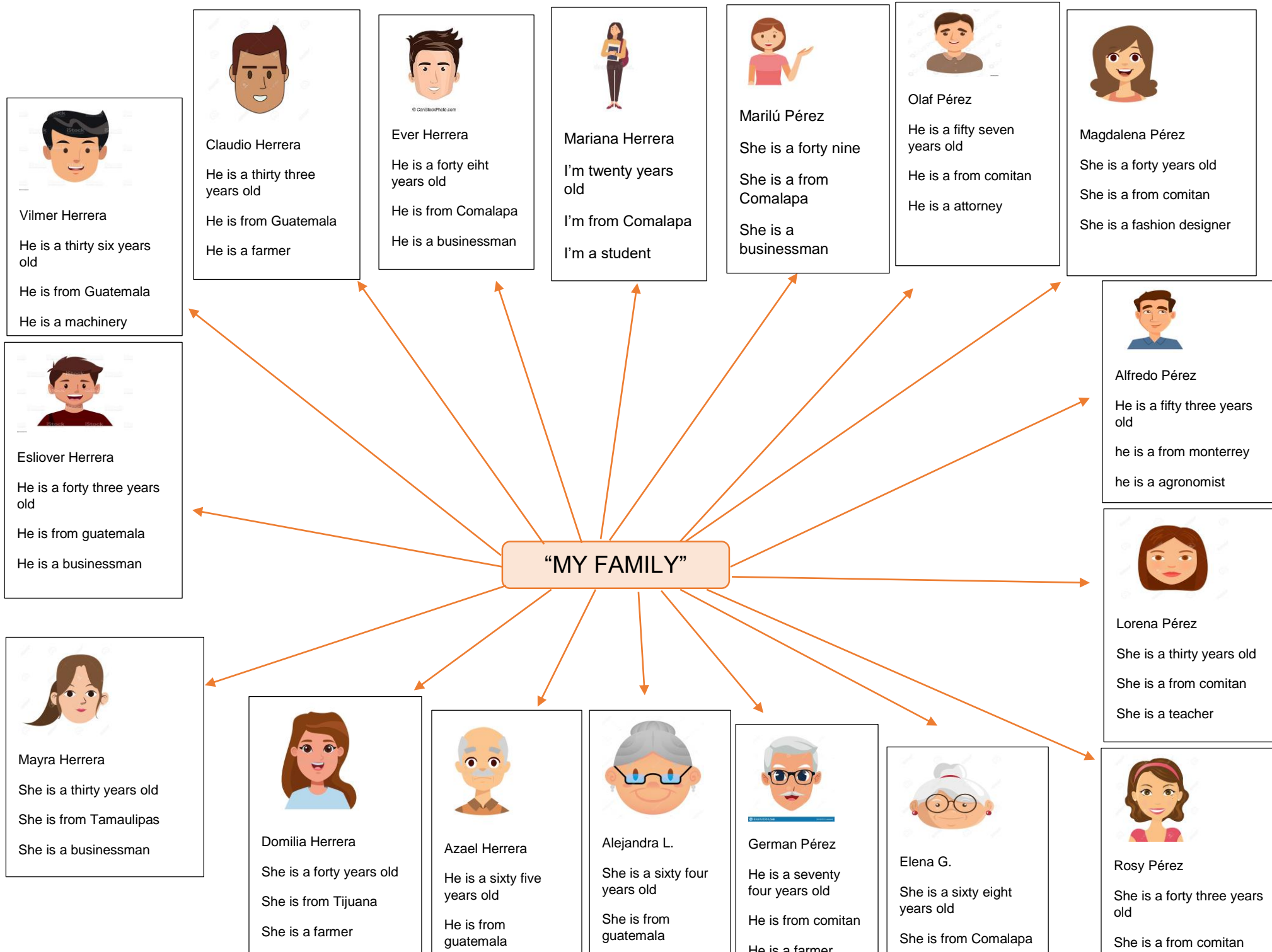

• **Sicknesses**

I have a cold.

We also use the verb have/has to describe:

• someone's eyes

• Someone's hair

My girlfriend has very long hair
