Formal

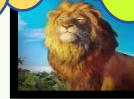
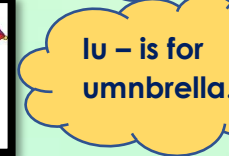
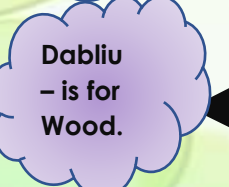
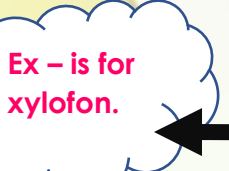

Definition

-The indeterminate or indefinite article.  
-Both ítems mean the same.

when is it used?

We use "an" before a word that begins with a vowel.

Example

"A"

He is a cook. He is a doctor. He is a fire fighter.  
He is a pilot. She is a bus driver. He is a police officer.  
He is a Farmer . she is a teacher. He is a fisherman. She is a dentist.

"AN"

she is an nurse. she is an student.
