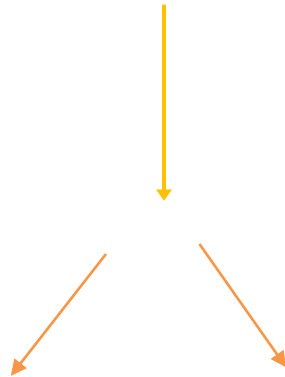

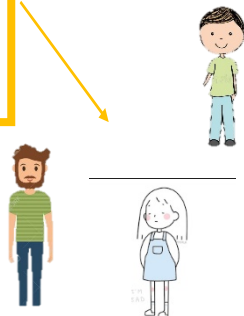

Proper names are nouns that are used to designate people, places, events, companies or things with a singular name

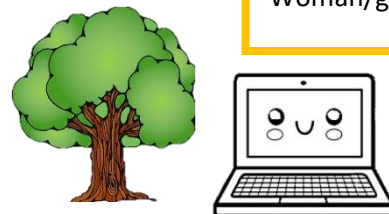

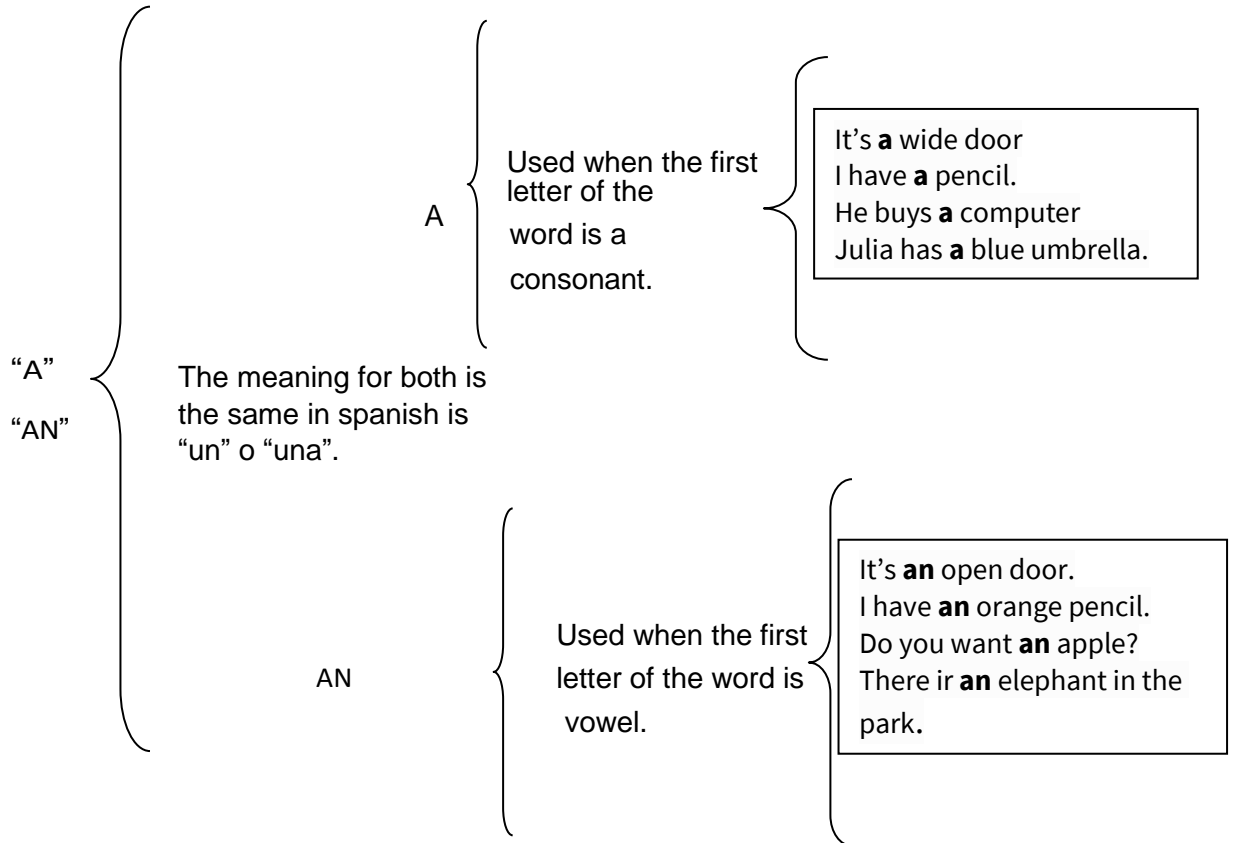
