You	are	Tú eres/ Estás
He	is	ÉL es/ Está
She	is	Ella es/ Está
It	is	Ello es/ Está
We	are	Nosotros somos/ Estamos
You	are	Ustedes son/ Están
They	Are	Ellos son/ Están

It	Is not	No es/No está
We	Are not	Nosotros no somos/ nosotros no estamos
