NAME ANY PEOPLE, PERSON, THING, OR IDEA

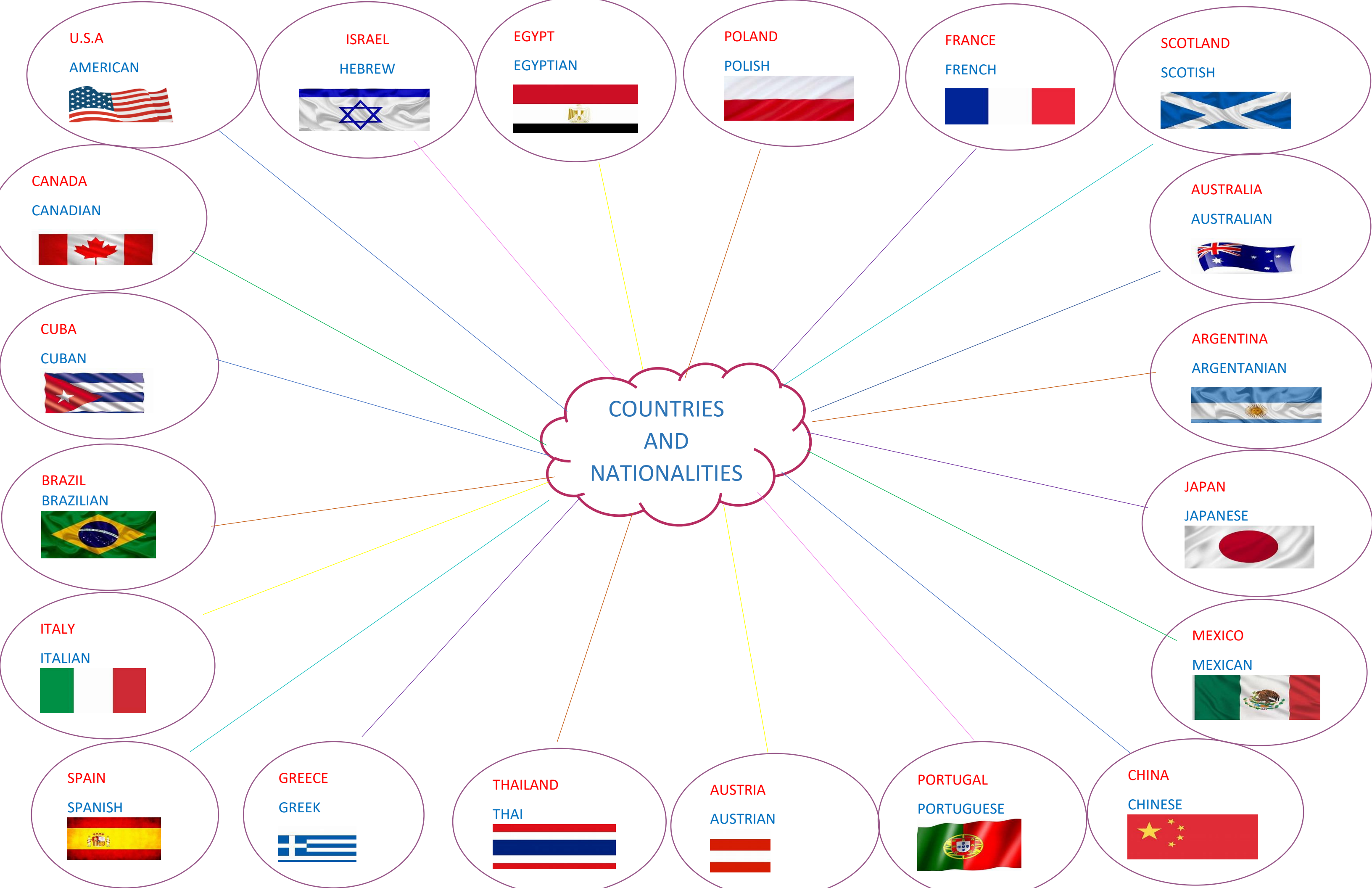
PROPER NOUNS:

WE USE **A** WHEN THE WORD HAVE CONSONANTS SOUND

FOR EXAMPLE:

- HE IS **A** COOK
- SHE IS **A** DENTIST
- HE IS **A** DOCTOR
- HE IS **A** FIRE FIGHTER
- HE IS **A** PILOT
- SHE IS **A** BUS DRIVER
- SHE IS **A** NURSE
- HE IS **A** POLICE OFFICER
- HE IS **A** FARMER
- SHE IS **A** TEACHER
- SHE IS **A** STUDENT
- HE IS **A** FISHERMAN

WE USE **AN** WHEN THE WORD HAVE VOWEL SOUND

FOR EXAMPLE:

- HE IS **AN** ARCHAEOLOGIST
- SHE IS **AN** ARCHITECT
