She is a student



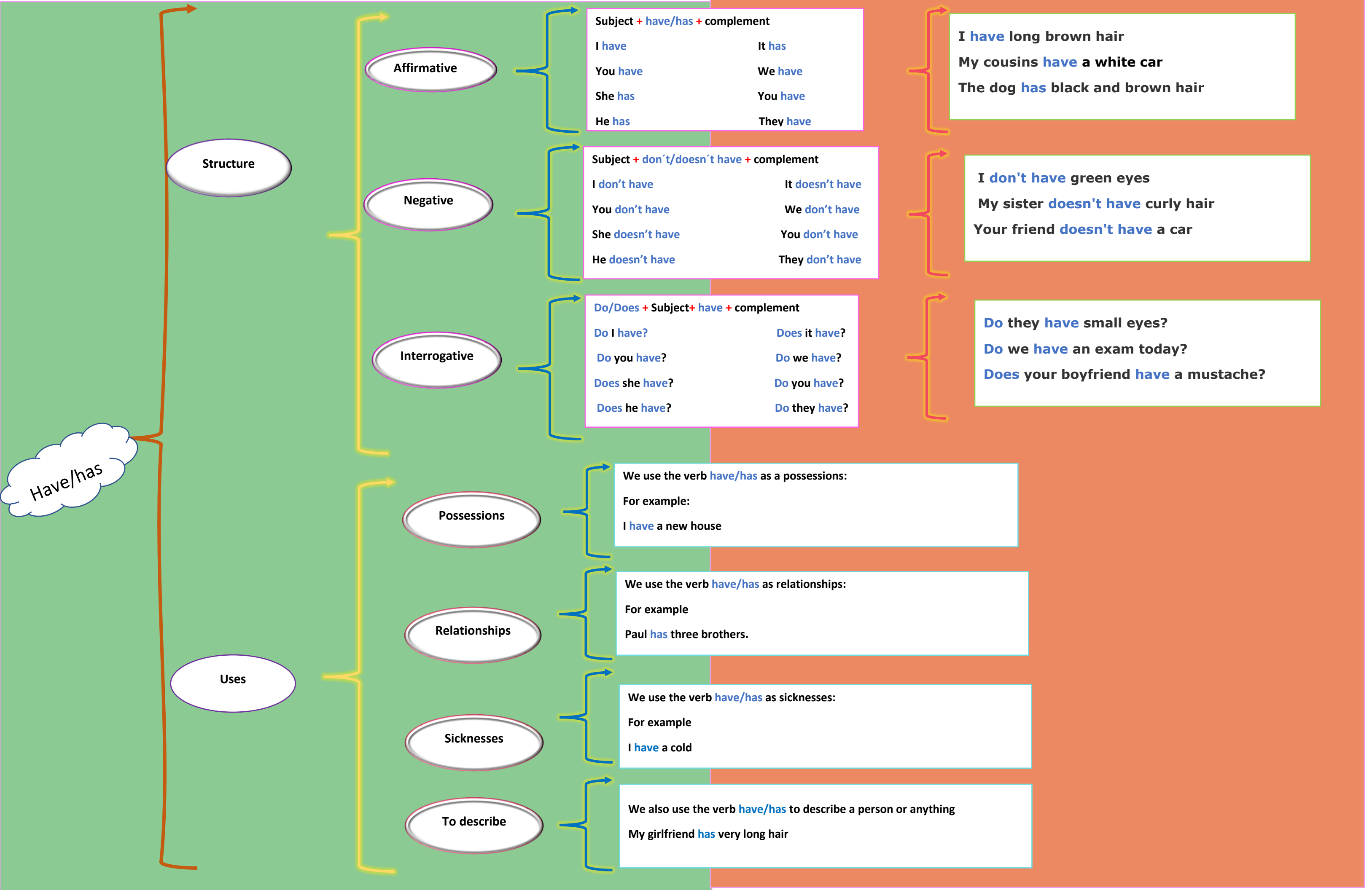

Have/has

Structure

Affirmative

Subject + have/has + complement
 I have It has
 You have We have
 She has You have
 He has They have

I have long brown hair
 My cousins have a white car
 The dog has black and brown hair

Negative

Subject + don't/doesn't have + complement
 I don't have It doesn't have
 You don't have We don't have
 She doesn't have You don't have
 He doesn't have They don't have

I don't have green eyes
 My sister doesn't have curly hair
 Your friend doesn't have a car

Interrogative

Do/Does + Subject + have + complement
 Do I have? Does it have?
 Do you have? Do we have?
 Does she have? Do you have?
 Does he have? Do they have?

Do they have small eyes?
 Do we have an exam today?
 Does your boyfriend have a mustache?

Uses

Possessions

We use the verb have/has as a possessions:
 For example:
 I have a new house

Relationships

We use the verb have/has as relationships:
 For example
 Paul has three brothers.

Sicknesses

We use the verb have/has as sicknesses:
 For example
 I have a cold

To describe

We also use the verb have/has to describe a person or anything
 My girlfriend has very long hair

She **has** small eyes

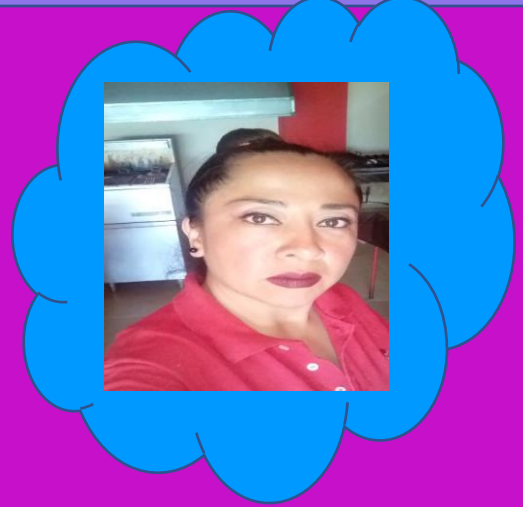
She **has** a very long hair

I **have** a very long hair I **don't have** a house

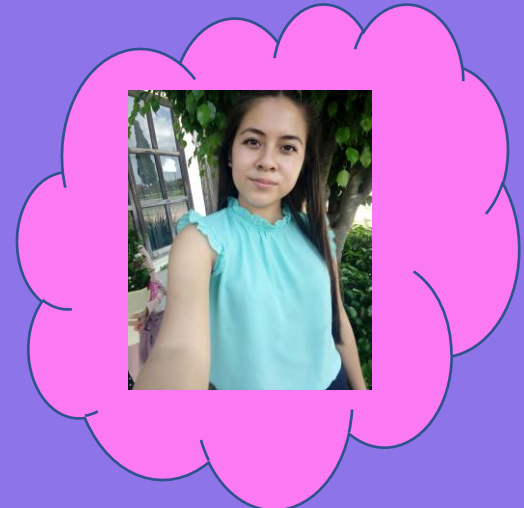
I **have** straight brown hair
