

VERB TO BE







The verb to be:

It means to be or to have according to the context, and it is the most used verb in the English language and also the most important. It is used as a main verb and as an auxiliary, and it is irregular in the past and present.

Affirmative I am or I'm. I am a student or I'm student.
AM Image: Am i a student or l'm not. Image: Am i a student or l'm not a student. Interrogative Image: Am i a student? Image: Am i a student or l'm not a student.
