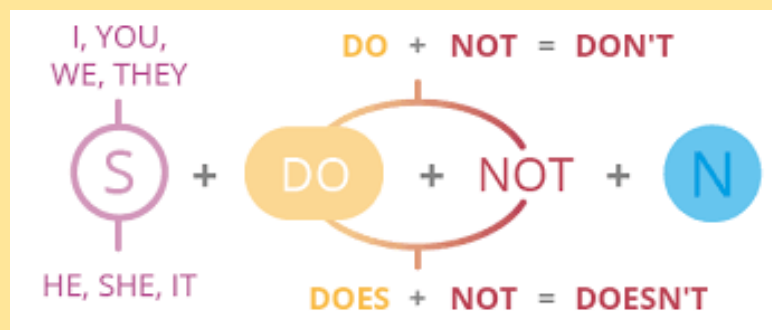

Existe una forma de identificar cual se utiliza en cada oración.

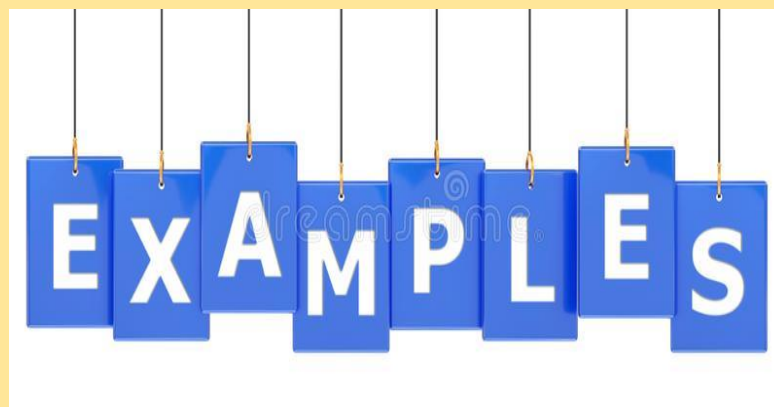
- I } Don't

- WE } Don't
- YOU } Don't
- THEY } Don't
