# PRONOMBRE DEMOSTRATIVOS

## "ONE" Y "ONES"

One is a pronoun that is used to replace a countable noun in the singular, thus avoiding unnecessary repetition.

Instead, we'll use ones when it substitutes countable plural nouns.

### EXAMPLES OF ONE AND ONES



- I've bought these two lipsticks.



- Whose are these socks?
