We use the subject pronouns with verbs. Examples: you listen, they read, etc. We use the possessive

adjectives with nouns: my sister, your family, their cat, etc.

Example: I'm Mary and this is Sid, my husband.

Example: Her husband's name is Nick and he's a doctor. Example: These are their two children - our grandchildren.

Example: It's a very nice photo, I think.

Possessive's

- We use a name (Nick, etc.) or a noun for a person (sister, etc.) + 's for the possessive. Example: Fiona is Nick's wife. It's my sister's car.

We can also use's with other nouns for people.
 Example: it's my teacher's car. It's his friend's camera., etc.

For plural nouns, we write s`.
 Example: he`s my friends`son.

TIPS: 's can mean "is" or the possessive.

Example: Anne's my sister. ('s = is); Kevin is Nick's son. ('s = possessive).






