

Verb to be (singular)

AFFIRMATIVE (+)

I'm (= I am)	I`m British.
you`re (= you are)	You`re a student.
he's (=he is)	He`s German.
she's (= she is)	She`s Brazilian.
it`s(= it is)	It's American.

We use it for a thing (a car, a book, etc.) Example: a German car, an English book.

NEGATIVE (-)

I'm not (= I am not)	I'm not American.
you aren't (= are not)	You aren't a teacher.
he isn't (= is not)	He isn't from Berlin.
she isn't (= is not)	She isn't Australian.
it isn't (= is not)	It isn't a Mercedes.

TIPS: We can also say "you`re not", "he`s not". and "it`s not". Example: you`re not a teacher.

YES/NO QUESTIONS (?)	SHORT ANSWER
Am I in this class?	Yes, you are. No, you aren`t.
Are you from Russia?	Yes, I am. No, I`m not.
Is he a doctor?	Yes, he is. No, he isn`t.
Is she Italian?	Yes, she is. No, she isn`t.
Is it Japanese?	Yes, it is. No, it isn`t.

TIPS: We can also say: "No, you're not". "No, he's not". "No, she's not" and "No, it's not". We can't say "Yes, you're", "Yes, I'm", "Yes, he's".
