





# GRAMMAR Verb to be (singular)

# AFFIRMATIVE (+)

I'm (= I am)	I'm British.
you're (= you are)	You're a student.
he's (=he is)	He's German.
she's (= she is)	She's Brazilian.
it's(= it is)	It's American.

We use it for a thing (a car, a book, etc.) Example: a German car, an English book.

## NEGATIVE (-)

I'm not (= I am not)	I'm not American.	
you aren't (= are not)	You aren't a teacher.	
he isn't (= is not)	He isn't from Berlin.	
she isn't (= is not)	She isn't Australian.	
it isn't (= is not)	It isn't a Mercedes.	

TIPS: We can also say "you`re not", "he`s not", and "it`s not".


Example: you`re not a teacher.

YES/NO QUESTIONS (?)	SHORT ANSWER
Am I in this class?	Yes, you are. No, you aren't.
Are you from Russia?	Yes, I am. No, I'm not.
Is he a doctor?	Yes, he is. No, he isn't.
Is she Italian?	Yes, she is. No, she isn't.
Is it Japanese?	Yes, it is. No, it isn't.


TIPS: We can also say: "No, you're not". "No, he's not". "No, she's not" and "No, it's not". We can't say "<del>Yes, you're"</del>, "<del>Yes, I'm"</del>, "<del>Yes, he's".</del>
