<b><u>Oraciones positivas</u></b> Nota que el verbo va en pasado y utilizamos una expresión de tiempo.	<b>I went to the park last Monday.</b>
	<b>Yo fui al parque el lunes pasado</b>
<b><u>Oraciones negativas</u></b> Nota que el AUXILIAR es el que absorbe la conjugación en pasado y el verbo principal queda en FORMA BASE	<b>I didn't watch a movie last night.</b>
	<b>Yo no vi una película anoche</b>
<b><u>Preguntas de si y no</u></b> Cuando hacemos este tipo de preguntas siempre iniciamos con el verbo AUXILIAR, en este caso es el verbo DO EN PASADO	<b>Did your family travel to Tuxtla?</b>
	<b>¿Viajó tu familia a Tuxtla?</b>
<b><u>Preguntas de información</u></b> Al realizar estas preguntas siempre comenzamos con una palabra de WH (what, when, where, why, how) Después continuamos como lo hacemos con las preguntas de si y no Palabra WH + auxiliar DID + verbo FORMA BASE + complemento	<b>Where did you go last summer?</b>
	<b>¿A dónde fuiste el verano pasado?</b>
