<u>Oraciones positivas</u> Nota que el verbo va en pasado y utilizamos una expresión de tiempo.	I went to the park last Monday.
	Yo fui al parque el lunes pasado
<u>Oraciones negativas</u> Nota que el AUXILIAR es el que absorbe la conjugación en pasado y el verbo principal queda en FORMA BASE	I didn't watch a movie last night.
	Yo no vi una película anoche
<u>Preguntas de si y no</u> Cuando hacemos este tipo de preguntas siempre iniciamos con el verbo AUXILIAR, en este caso es el verbo DO EN PASADO	Did your family travel to Tuxtla?
	¿Viajó tu familia a Tuxtla?
<u>Preguntas de información</u> Al realizar estas preguntas siempre comenzamos con una palabra de WH (what, when, where, why, how) Después continuamos como lo hacemos con las preguntas de si y no Palabra WH + auxiliar DID + verbo FORMA BASE + complemento	Where did you go last summer?
	¿A dónde fuiste el verano pasado?
