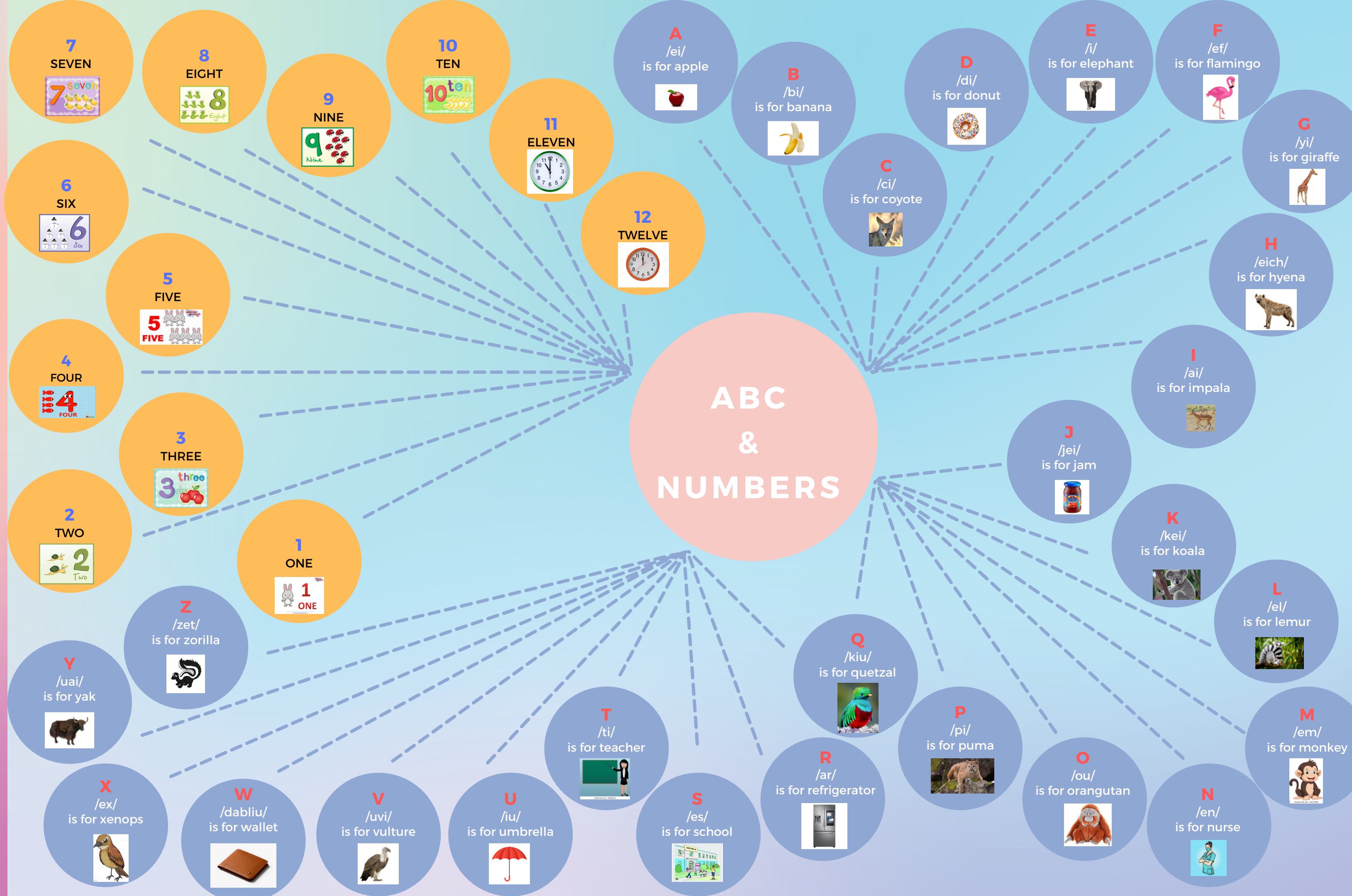

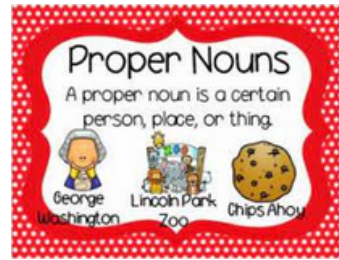

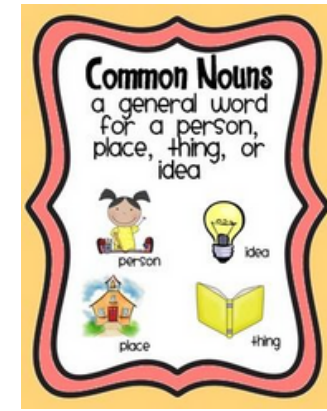

WHAT IS YOUR JOB?

INDEFINITE ARTICLE A

It is a word that refers to something that is not specific. The meaning of these words in Spanish is the same: UN or UNA

With nouns that begin with a consonant

EXAMPLES

- HE IS **A** COOK
- SHE IS **A** DENTIST
- HE IS **A** DOCTOR
- HE IS **A** FIRE FIGHTER
- HE IS **A** PILOT
- SHE IS **A** BUS DRIVER
- SHE IS **A** NURSE
- HE IS **A** POLICE OFFICER
- HE IS **A** FARMER
- SHE IS **A** TEACHER
- SHE IS **A** STUDENT
- HE IS **A** FISHER MAN

INDEFINITE ARTICLE AN

It is a word that refers to something that is not specific. The meaning of these words in Spanish is the same: UN or UNA

With nouns that start with a vowel

EXAMPLES

- SHE IS **AN** ACTRESS
- HE IS **AN** AMAZING PAINTER
- HE IS **AN** ENGINEER
- IT IS **AN** INTERNATIONAL COMPANY
- SHE IS **AN** OPERA SINGER
- IT IS **AN** UNUSUAL JOB

EXCEPTIONS

1. WHEN THE H SOUND IS MUTE (DOES NOT SOUND) / He left an hour ago

2. WHEN U IS A SEMICONSONANT / We wear a uniform every day
