AFIRMATIVE FORM : Affirmative sentences are those that clearly state something that, in general, is assumed to be true or true. It is used very frequently to communicate.

To be forma afirmativa

- I am / I'm = Soy o estoy
- You are / You're = Eres o estás
- He is / He's = Es o está
- She is / She's = Es o está
- It is / It's = Es o está

NEGATIVE FORM : The negative form of the verb is applied to deny the action indicated by the verb. It is made up of the person followed by the conjugated **DO** auxiliary, followed the infinitive. When it comes to the third person singular, the auxiliary to use is **DOES**

NEGATIVE FORM / FORMA NEGATIVA:

Forma Sem Contracção	Forma Contraída
I am not	I'm not
You are not	You aren't
He is not	He isn't
She is not	She isn't
It is not	It isn't
We are not	We aren't
You are not	You aren't
They are not	They aren't

INTERROGATIVE FORM AND SHORT ANSWERS : An interrogative sentence is a sentence used to ask for information and sometimes to express more information or suggestions pragmatically softened.

In short answer questions (PRC), students must answer the opened questions with a word or short sentence
