

Negative sentences in the past tense

Negative sentences deny what the verb wants to express. They are always accompanied by adverbs



Forming negative sentences in the 3 most-used verb tenses	
Present Simple Add "don't" ("doesn't" for he/she/it)	We don't eat dogs. <i>No comemos perros.</i> She doesn't eat dogs. <i>Ella <u>no</u> come perros.</i>
Past Simple Add "didn't"	I didn't eat the dog. <i>No <u>comí</u> el perro.</i>
Future Simple Add "won't"	We won't eat the dog. <i>No <u>comeremos</u> el perro.</i>



¿How to make a negative sentence?

To make a negative sentence you must add the auxiliary verb do, does, o did, and then simply not.

- I **didn't** play soccer last night
- She **didn't** make any problems
- He **didn't** cry a lot
- it **didn't** work
- They **didn't** like the new song
