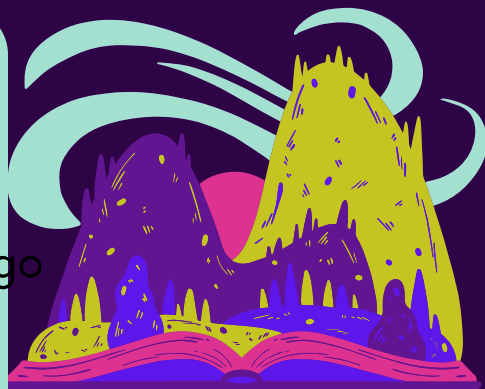


# SUPER NOTE

They didn't work together for many years.

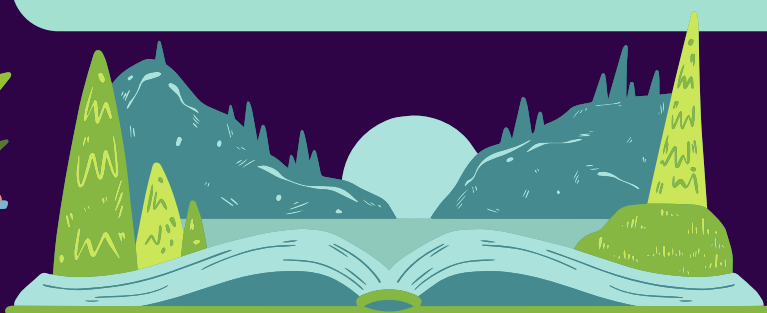


He didn't have a cold last week
