## **AFFIRMATIVES**

I am going to to cook for her.

My brother is going to visit us tomorrow

You are going to study to be a lawye.

I am going to get up early tomorrow.

She is going to give him a kiss.

You are going to do it

Jane is going to start her new job next week.

She is going to leave for Europe on Monday...

He is going to visit her next week

## **NEGATIVES**

Los pronombres sujetos y la forma conjugada del verbo to be se pueden contraer.

You aren't going to stay here
She isn't going to have a baby

They aren't going to eat pizza

She isn't gonna leave

It isn't gonna rain

I am not going to write a letter

We are not going to fix that

## **INTERROGATIVES**

Las oraciones interrogativas del futuro idiomático se forman invirtiendo el orden del sujeto y el verbo to be, manteniendo el resto de la estructura intacta.

Is Paul going to buy a car?no ,he isnt

Is she going to have a baby?no ,she isnt

Are they going to eat pizza? No, they arent

Am I going to write a letter? Yes, I'm

Are we going to fix that?yes, we are

Is she gonna leave? No,she isnt Are you going to stay here? Yes,I am

Is it gonna rain? No I am not
