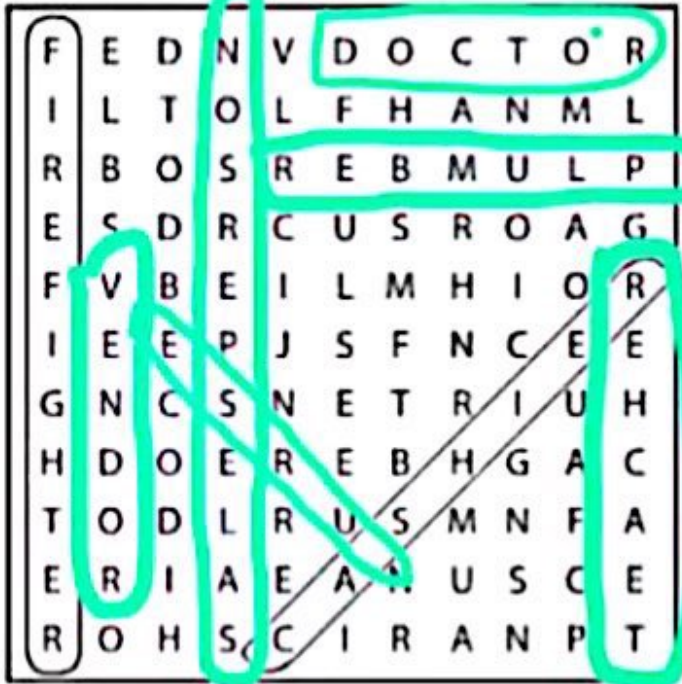


panadero

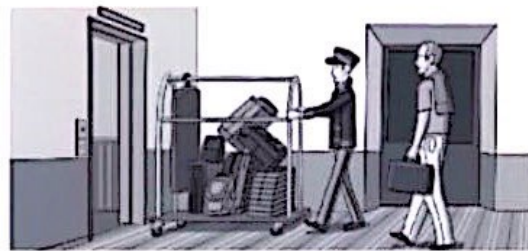

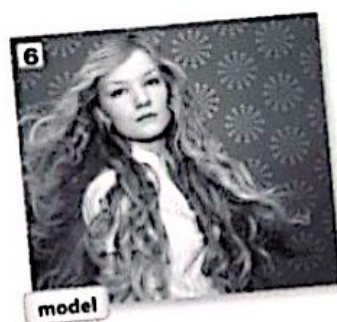
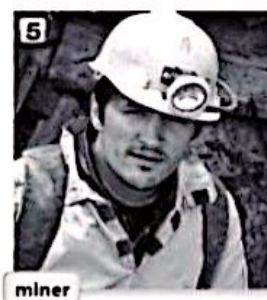
