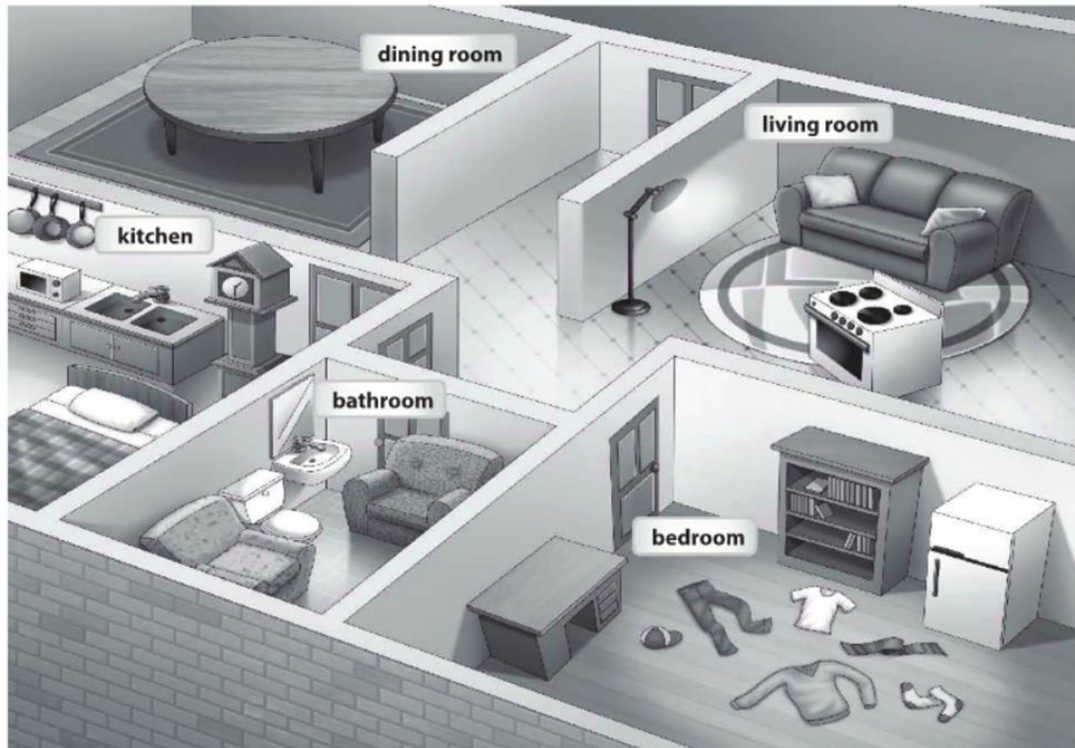

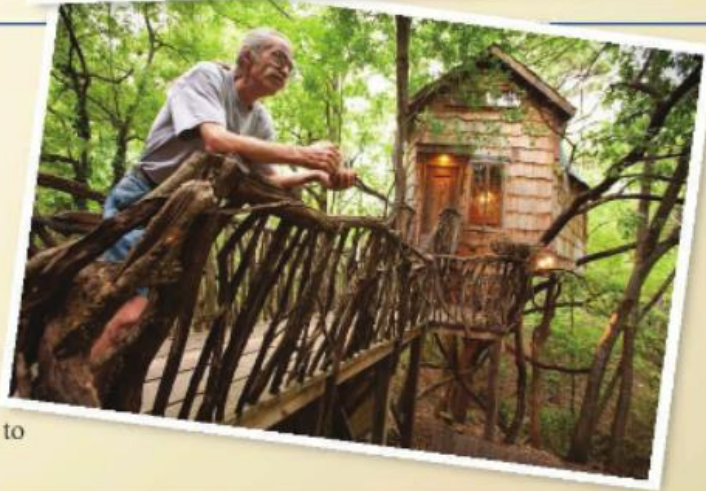
Unusual Homes
