RUTORIZED Adverbs of frequency usually go before the main verb: always, almost always, usually, often, sometimes, hardly ever, almost never, never. She never plays tennis, l almost always eat breakfast. Sometimes can begin a sentence: Sometimes I own eat breakfast.




