How can I get to Bryant Park?

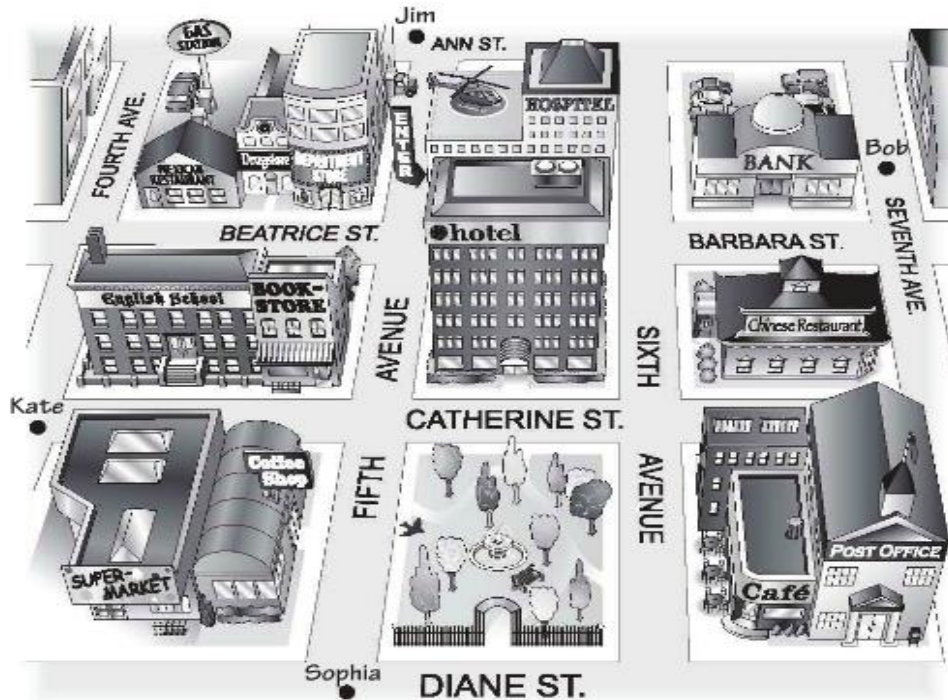
Walk down/Go down Fifth Avenue.
