


# HISTORIA NATURAL DE LA ENFERMEDAD





Figura 3 Historia natural de la enfermedad. Fuente: (OMS/OPS, 2011)





### Clasificación de las concepciones de "Salud"




Enfoque funcional

“Es el estado de completo bienestar físico, mental y social y no sólo la ausencia de la enfermedad.”

Capacidad de funcionar o el estado de capacidad óptima de un individuo ante el cumplimiento eficaz de sus funciones o tareas para las que ha sido preparado.



**Factores intrínsecos al individuo:** Están determinadas por elementos genéticos, edad, sexo.

**Factores extrínsecos al individuo:** Ligados a condiciones del medio ambiente en el que el individuo se desenvuelve, y se divide en naturales y sociales

Bacterias, virus, protozoarios, hongos, plantas, invertebrados, vertebrados



## Físico

Calor, frío, geográficos, desastres, radiaciones, ruidos, daños por objetos



## Químico

Sustancias químicas, toxinas, venenos, gases



Hábitat normal en cualquier ser vivo que permite el alojamiento, subsistencia y desarrollo de un agente causal.



Elemento responsable de la enfermedad o daño en el huésped (biológico, físico, químico, social).



Las condiciones externas (social, biológico y físico) en donde ocurre la interacción entre el ambiente y el huésped.



La modificación o desequilibrio de algunos de los componentes de la triada, ocasiona la enfermedad



Lasaludes la homeostasis (equilibrio) entre el agente, huésped y ambiente.
