GRAMMAR Adverbs of Frequency



Adverbs of frequency go after "be" but before other verbs.

Example: I'm <u>always</u> tired on Sundays. Example: I <u>usually</u> watch sport on TV.

Always: Siempre
Usually: Usualmente
Often: Frecuentemente
Sometimes: Algunas veces
Occasionally: Ocacionalmente

Seldom: Pocas veces

Hardly ever / rarely: Raramente

Never: Nunca
