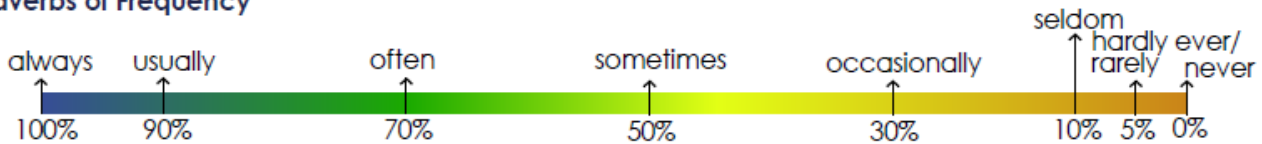

Adverbs of Frequency



Adverbs of frequency go after “be” but before other verbs.

Example: I’m always tired on Sundays.

Example: I usually watch sport on TV.

- Always: Siempre**
- Usually: Usualmente**
- Often: Frecuentemente**
- Sometimes: Algunas veces**
- Occasionally: Ocasionalmente**
- Seldom: Pocas veces**
- Hardly ever / rarely: Raramente**
- Never: Nunca**

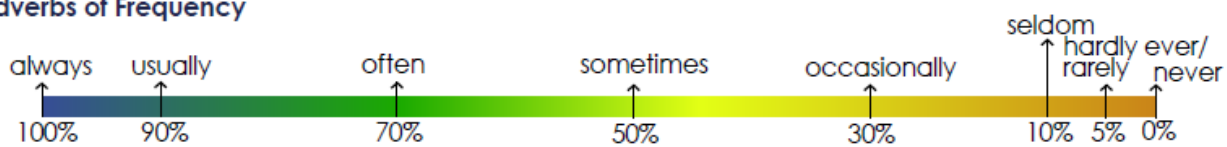

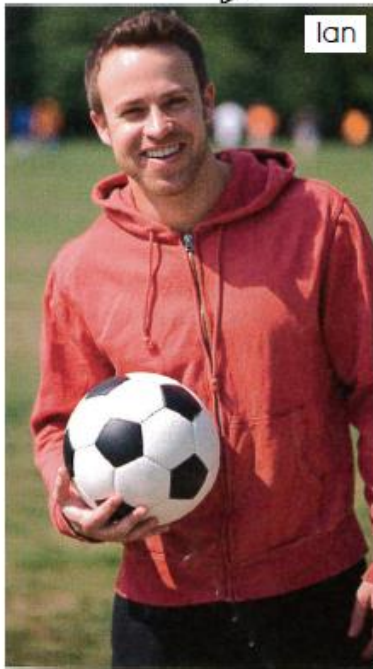
