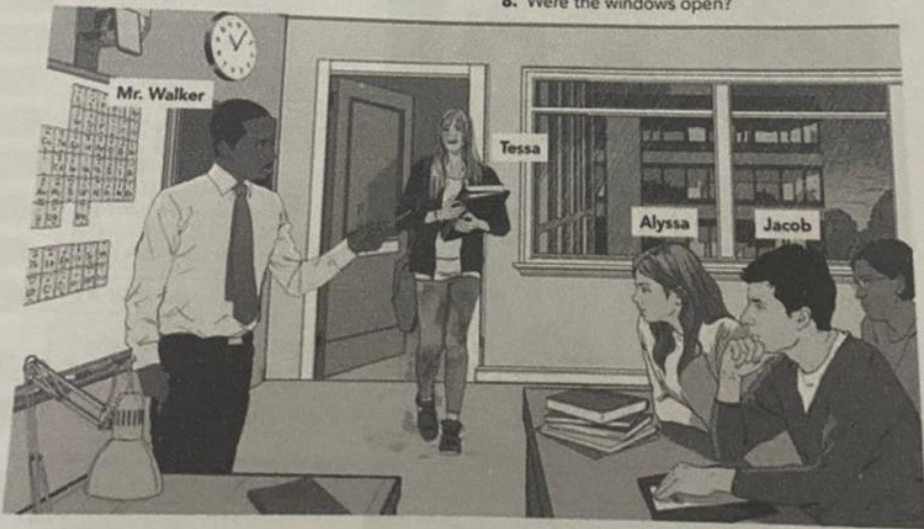
**A** Bianca is talking about her family. Choose the correct verb forms. Then compare with a partner.

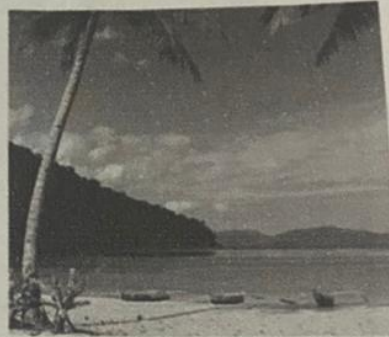
