RULES

ALL VERBS MUST EN IN-ING.

FOR VERBS ENDING IN SILEN -E, THIS MUST BE REPLACED WITH -ING

WHEN VERB ENDS IN-IE, THESE LETTERS SHOULD BE REPLACED WITH -Y AND -ING

STRUCTURE

AFFIRMATIVE
SUBJECT+VERB TO BE+
ING+ OBJECT

NEGATIVE
SUBJECT+ VERB TO BE+
NOT+ING+OBJECT

INTERROGATIVE
VERB TO BE+ SUBJECT+
ING+OBJECT+?

I AM NOT LISTENING TO MUSIC
