Simple present statements

The **Present Simple** tense describes things that are true, actions that happen many times, and simple statements of fact.

"HE STUDIES MEDICAL PET CARE"



Simple present statements with irregular verbs

An **irregular verb** is a verb that doesn't follow the regular inflection, or ending to the word, that's expected when putting it into the past tense or past participle.

"THE DOG TOOK THAT BOOK TO READ"

Simple present question

We use **do** and **does** to make questions with the **present simple**. We use **does** for the third person singular (she/he/it) and **do** for the others.

"DOES REX THE DOG PLAY CARD GAMES??"
