

The **Present Simple** tense describes things that are true, actions that happen many times, and simple statements of fact.

Simple present statements with irregular verbs

An irregular verb is a verb that doesn't follow the regular inflection, or ending to the word, that's expected when putting it into the past tense or past participle.

"THE DOG TOOK THAT BOOK TO READ"

Simple present question

We use do and does to make questions with the present simple. We use does for the third person singular (she/he/it) and do for the others.
