Simple present statements with irregular verbs

-in affirmative statements, verbs with
he/she/it end in :S.

*In negative statements, use doesn't with
he/she it and don't with he/she/ it and don't
with all the others:he/she/it doesn't live here. i
you/we/they don' live here

-Don't add-s to the verbs: she doesn't live here

at noon-At night

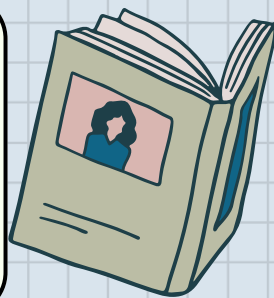


TIME EXPRESSIONS

In questions, use does with he/she/it and do with all the others: Does he/she/it get up early? Do I/you /we/they get up early



Don't add -s to the verb: Does she live alone?
