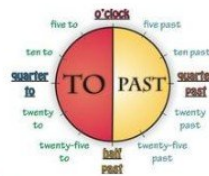

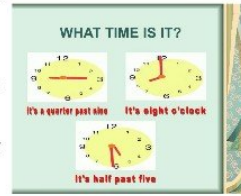

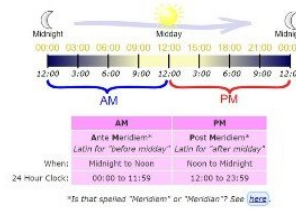
WHAT TIME IS IT?

- In questions, the be verb comes before the subject
- To form the continuous of verbs ending in -e, drop the e and add -ing have
- For verbs ending in vowel + consonant get- getting
