

Negative auxiliaries in present.

Don't.

1. I don't eat chicken.
2. You don't eat fruit.
3. We don't run in National Park.
4. They don't talk in class.
5. I don't usually dance.

7. We don't sing in the car.

Doesn't.

1. Lucia doesn't know how to sing.
2. Lupita doesn't go to school.
3. The dog doesn't want to eat.

5. He doesn't have a girlfriend.
6. He doesn't go to his party.
7. She doesn't sing in the bathroom.

Interrogative auxiliaries in present.

Do.

1. Do I dance at night? Yes, I do.

4. Do they run in the morning? No, they don't.
5. Do I jump ropes in the afternoons? Yes, I do.
6. Do we cook pizza on Saturdays? No, we don't.

Does.
