(interrogative)

  5. Has she bought a new house? Yes, she has.

1. Who has a lot of money? Rosy.
  2. Who has a new car? Peter.
  3. What color has his eyes? Brown.
  4. Who has to read the book on the weekend? Sophie.
  5. Who has a new house? Naya

**HAVE**  
(affirmative)

1. I have a pet.
2. Luis y Mario have an appointment tomorrow.
3. We have bought the house.
4. They have to repaired the roof.
5. We have been living in Australia for two months.

**HAVE**  
(negative)

1. I haven't a pet.
2. Luis y Mario haven't an appointment tomorrow.
3. We haven't bought the house.
4. They haven't to repaired the roof.
5. We haven't been living in Australia for two months.

**HAVE**  
(interrogative)

1. Have a pet? No, I haven't.
2. Have Luis y Mario an appointment tomorrow? Yes, you have.
3. Have we bought the house? yes, we have.
4. Have they to repaired the roof? Yes, they have.
5. Have we been living in Australia for two months

**HAVE (Q.W)**

1. Who has a pet? I have.
2. Who has an appointment tomorrow? Luis y Mario
3. What have they bought? A house.
4. What do they have repaired? The roof.
5. How long have you been living here in Australia? Two months.
