# PRESENT SIMPLE



## 1. PRESENT SIMPLE

Sujeto + verbo + complemento

El present simple en inglés es el tiempo verbal indicado cuando quieras expresar alguna de las siguientes condiciones:

- Dar a conocer acciones o estados permanentes

Ejemplo: Guadalajara is the capital of Jalisco

- Comunicar acciones o estados que se repiten en el tiempo

Ejemplo: Every four years is a leap year

Transmitir rutinas, hechos continuos y que se repiten de forma diaria o con periodicidad determinada

Ejemplo: I walk to my work

- Dar instrucciones o indicaciones

Ejemplo: First, smash the potatoes and then pour some milk

- Mencionar hechos, compromisos o citas que ocurrirán en el futuro en una hora y día determinados

Ejemplo: Next Saturday is my wedding

Do you like burgers?

Does she like burgers?

Do Charles and Gaby dance?

Does she watch TV on weekends?

DO y DOES son auxiliares que se usan para hacer preguntas en el Presente Simple en inglés

**Do**

Se usa con los pronombres I, YOU, WE, THEY

Do + sujeto (I, you, we, they) + verbo + complemento?

Do you cook every day? >> ¿Usted cocina todos los días?

Do they read at night? >> ¿Ellos leen por la noche?

**Does**

Se usa con los pronombres HE, SHE, IT

Does + sujeto (he, she, it) + verbo sin S + complemento?

Does he cook every day? >> ¿Él cocina todos los días?

Does she read at night? >> ¿Ella lee por noche?
