VERB TO BE

AFFIRMATIVE FORM

Affirmative sentences are those that declare or affirm something that is real.

Subject + verb to be + complement

Examples

1. I am in at school
2. You are a student
3. He is a doctor
4. She is a teacher
5. It is a pen
6. We are in New York
7. They are my kids

NEGATIVE FORM

Negative sentences are those that deny something. Therefore, the particle not is added after the verb.

Subjet + verb to be + not + complement

Examples

1. I am not tired.
2. You aren't busy.
3. He's not at work.
4. She's not my wife.
5. It's not for kids.
6. We're not strong.
7. They're not on holiday.

INTERROGATIVE FORM

Interrogative sentences or questions are those that are used to ask for certain information.

Verb to be + subjbet + complement +?
