They were racists
It The house was painted red.

NEGATIVE

subject + was / were + not + complement

I wasn't at the beach this morning
You weren't very happy in your childhood
He wasn't at the cinema with
We weren't home on Sunday
Amy wasn't 22 last year
They weren't best Friends at school
It wasn't cold yesterday

INTEROGATIVE

was / were + subject + complement

Was I in the picture?
Were you sad last night?
Was he your favorite?
Were we lost?
Was she at the party?
Were they famous?
Was it your birthday on Sunday?
