Past form**

Affirmative form

Subject + was/were + complement

1.- **I was** at the movies yesterday.

2.- **You were** very happy.

3.- **He was** at the beach this morning.

4.- **She was** doing her homework.

5.- **It was** hot today.

6.- **We were** the best in the room.

7.- **They were** good friends.

Negative form

Subject + Wasn't/Weren't + Complement

1.- **I wasn't** happy to see you.

2.- **You weren't** very fast.

3.- **He wasn't** in his house.

4.- **She wasn't** sick yesterday.

5.- **It wasn't** a good movie.

6.- **We weren't** members of the club.

7.- **They weren't** here today.

Interrogative form

Was/Were + Subject + complement + ?

1.- **Was I** a good motorcyclist?
