Affirmative form
Subject + was/were + complement

- 1.- **I WAS WORKING IN THE AFTERNOON.**
- 2.- **YOU WERE VERY DANCER.**
- 3.- **HE WAS PLAYING LOTTERY .**
- 4.- **SHE WAS MAKING FOOD.**
- 5.- **IT WAS A VERY SONNY DAY**
- 6.- **WE WERE THE MOST APPLIED IN THE CLASS.**
- 7.- **THEY WERE GOOD FRIENDS.**

Negative form
Subject + Wasn't/Weren't + Complement

- 1.- **I WASN'T AT THAT POOL PARTY.**
- 2.- **YOU WEREN'T A BAD FRIEND**
- 3.- **HE WASN'T INTO ROCK MUSIC.**
- 4.- **SHE WASN'T SICK YESTERDAY.**
- 5.- **IT WASN'T AT THAT POOL PARTY .**
- 6.- **WE WEREN'T THAT, ONLY FIVE MINUTES.**
- 7.- **THEY WEREN'T READY FOR THE TEST.**

Interrogative form
Was/Were + Subject + complement + ?
