► In questions, the *be* verb comes before the noun or pronoun: **Is he** your

Jennifer: **i'm** fine thanks.

Jennifer: **i'm** sorry

David: **it's** David

Jennifer: this **is**

Jennifer: **she's**

David: hi, sarah **it's** nice to meet you

Sarah: i think **you're** in my english class

David: yes , i **am**

2 The verb *be*

- ▶ In questions, the *be* verb comes before the noun or pronoun: **Is he** your teacher?
- ▶ Don't use contractions in short answers with Yes: Are you in my class? Yes, **I am**. (NOT: ~~Yes, I'm.~~)
