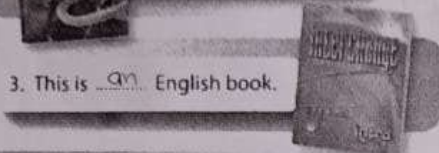

- ▶ Use *this* with singular nouns: **This is a book.** Use *these* with plural nouns: **These are earrings.**
