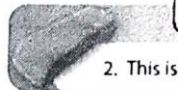

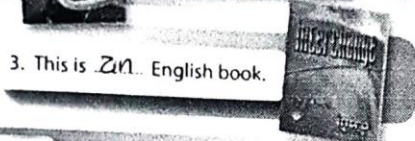

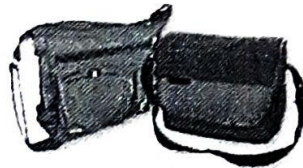

- ▶ Don't use a contraction with *What + are*: **What are these?** (NOT: **What're these?**)
- ▶ Use *this* with singular nouns: **This** is a book. Use *these* with plural nouns: **These** are earrings.

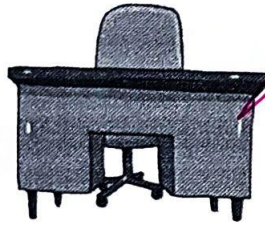

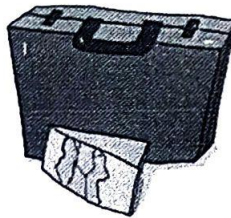
